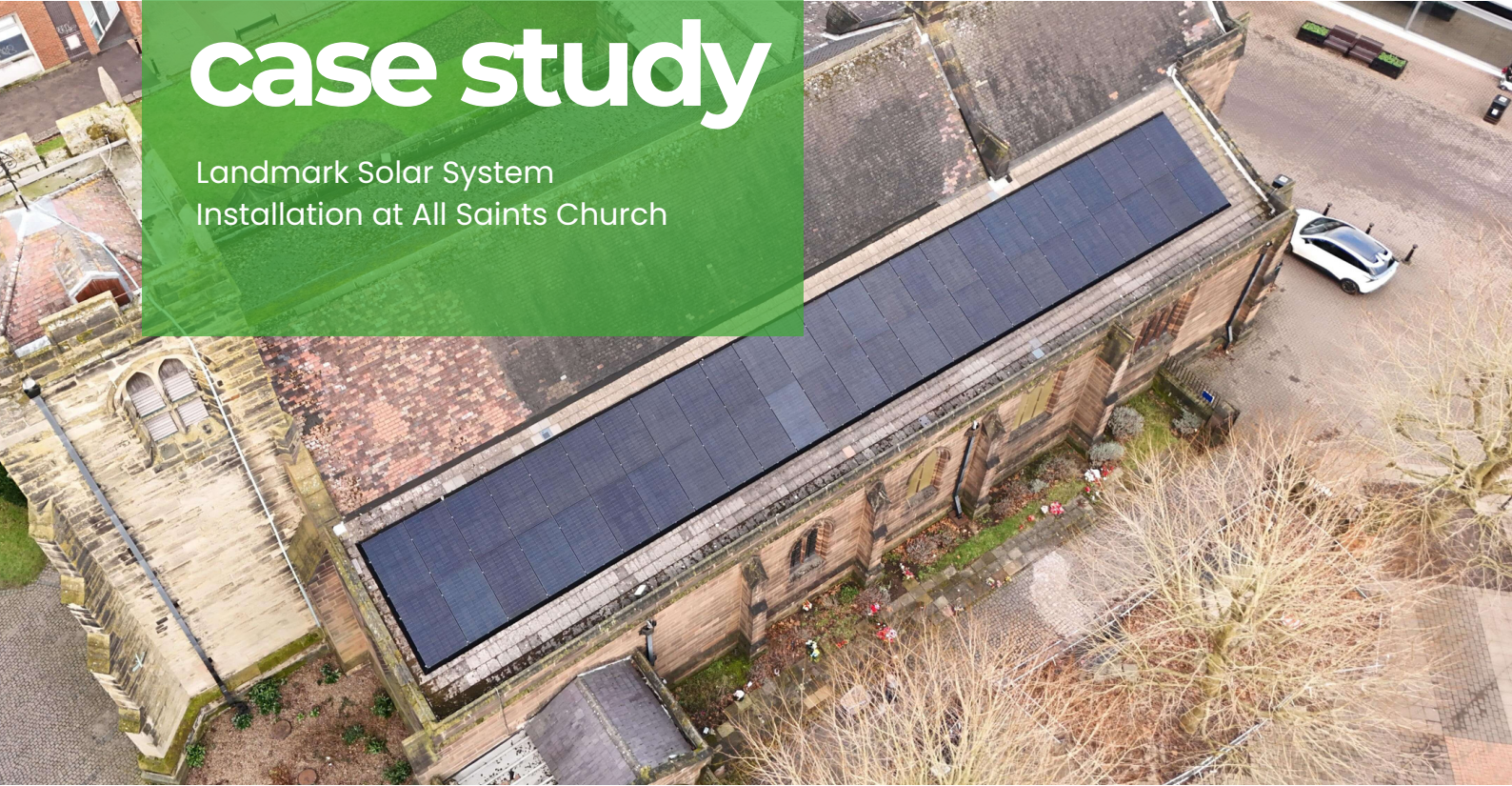

Landmark Solar System
Installation at All Saints Church



PROJECT OVERVIEW

All Saints Church in Bedworth embarked on an ambitious journey to enhance its sustainability profile and contribute to the Church of England's collective goal of becoming carbon neutral by 2030. Recognising the historic and cultural significance of the building—a Grade II* listed structure—the church sought a bespoke solution that would not only reduce its carbon footprint but also preserve its heritage aesthetics. Optimum Electrics was approached for a tailored quote, expert guidance, and comprehensive supportive materials. These resources played a pivotal role in securing backing from Historic England and positioning the church as a demonstrator project for sustainable practices within the Church of England.

DESIGN & CONSULTATION

Optimum Electrics worked with All Saints Church to design a bespoke solar system that maximised performance while respecting the building's historic character and meeting all planning requirements.

Key considerations included:

- Subtle appearance: All-black panels chosen to blend with the roofline.
- Space optimisation: Compact Sigenergy hybrid inverters and batteries used due to limited space.
- Planning compliance: Discreet cable routing and SolaSkirts installed to conceal rails and panel undersides.

VALUE: £40K

THE SYSTEM

The battery storage system was carefully tailored to meet the church's demanding energy requirements:

- **System Size: 25kW**
- **Components:**
 - 50x All Black Solar Panels
 - 1x 25kW Sigenergy Hybrid Inverter
 - 2 x 8kWh Sigenergy Batteries and 1 x 5kWh Battery

INSTALLATION

The installation took place over one week, with the team working Monday to Friday to minimise disruption to the church's daily activities and community groups. Optimum Electrics ensured that all work was conducted around the church's planned services, events, and programs.

CONCLUSION

This installation stands as a testament to how modern renewable energy solutions can be harmoniously integrated into historic buildings. With the support of Optimum Electrics, the church successfully navigated the challenges associated with its Grade II* listed status, secured planning permission, and achieved a state-of-the-art installation that not only cuts energy costs but also advances the Church of England's carbon neutrality goals.

Northamptonshire's Pioneering New Visitor Hub



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Optimum Electrics was appointed to deliver the electrical infrastructure supporting the interactive digital installations at Visit Northamptonshire's new visitor hub, a pioneering space designed to showcase the county's heritage, culture and tourism offering. Working alongside the wider project team and specialist AV providers, our role focused on delivering the power, containment and supporting electrical systems required to bring a series of immersive digital displays and interactive installations to life. The project required careful coordination with multiple trades to ensure a seamless integration of technology within the newly created visitor environment.

DESIGN & CONSULTATION

The visitor hub features a number of interactive exhibits designed to engage visitors through touchscreens, digital displays and media installations. Optimum Electrics worked closely with the project team to ensure the electrical infrastructure was carefully planned to support these systems while maintaining the clean, contemporary aesthetic of the space.

Key considerations included:

- Coordinating electrical infrastructure with specialist AV installations
- Ensuring reliable power distribution for sensitive digital equipment
- Concealing containment and cabling to maintain the visual design of the exhibition space
- Delivering installations that allowed easy maintenance and future upgrades

INSTALLATION

Optimum Electrics delivered a range of electrical works to support the visitor hub's interactive installations, including:

- Power infrastructure for interactive displays and digital exhibits
- Containment systems for data and AV cabling
- Electrical supplies for media equipment and integrated technology
- Coordination with AV specialists during installation and commissioning

Our team worked collaboratively with contractors and installation partners to ensure all electrical systems were safely installed, tested and ready for final commissioning of the visitor hub's digital experiences.

CONCLUSION

The completed visitor hub now provides an engaging and modern space where visitors can explore Northamptonshire through immersive digital experiences. By delivering the electrical infrastructure that supports these interactive installations, Optimum Electrics played a key role in helping bring the concept to life.
